## Craft Time

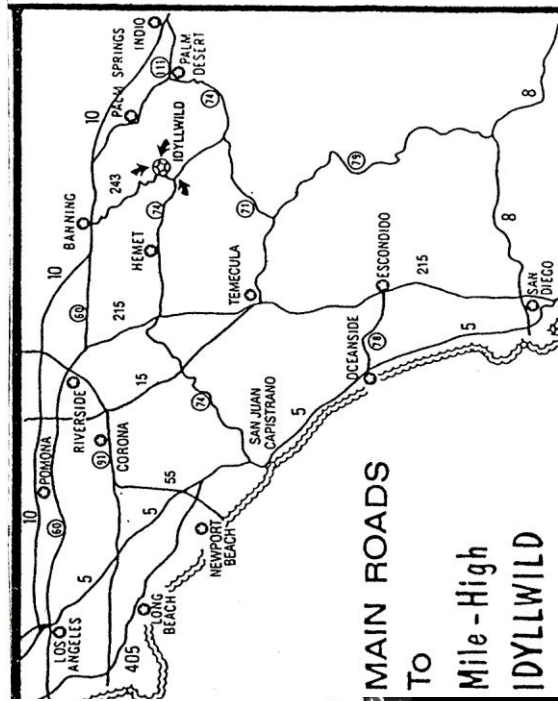
For \$10 or less we will have a craft for you to make and take home along with the knowledge needed to replicate your efforts on your own. Details to be announced at retreat.

*Shannon will be bringing us 4 messages this weekend on the following topics:*

1. **Sisterhood in the Church** – We will learn the biblical foundation of sisterhood and acquire the wisdom to know its purpose in the Kingdom of God
2. **Cultivating Sisterhood** – We will learn the building blocks of sisterhood and how to intentionally live out this role in the church.
3. **The Challenges of Sisterhood** – We will examine the pitfalls of sisterhood and how Jesus helps us overcome these challenges.
4. **Conflict Resolution in Sisterhood** – We will learn how to promote peace and walk in forgiveness in sisterhood.

### Cost:

- **Full weekend:** \$175 with Early Registration **by March 24<sup>th</sup>** \$195 after March 24<sup>th</sup>. *Includes lodging for two nights and 5 meals. Maximum of 4-5 women per room. Restrooms located inside the room. You must bring your own bedding.*
- **Saturday only:** \$90, must be registered by Friday, April 7<sup>th</sup>. Lunch and dinner are included. Full payment of \$90 due with registration. (non-refundable).
- **Nursing Infants:** \$0, must be registered by Friday, April 7<sup>th</sup> with the mother. This is specifically for young, nursing infants and only with the "Saturday only" option. There are no overnight accommodations for infants and no childcare will be offered during the day.
